Dear St. Martin's Parents and Families,

In order to be able to work through all the new changes, **all the schools in EICS are planning a staggered school start this year starting on Tuesday, Sept. 1.** For the first four days of school, about a quarter of the students will attend each day. We have coordinated this schedule with St. Mary's School in an attempt to accommodate our families with children that attend multiple schools. The first full day for all students will be Tuesday, Sept. 8th.

Use the letter of your child's last name (Check your homeroom Placement on Powerschool) to determine which day of staggered entry your child comes to school during Sept. 1 to Sept. 4 from 8:35 – 2:55 pm.

How to prepare:

You will need to use the **AHS Daily Screening Tool each day**, prior to coming to school, including our staggered entry days, linked [here](#).

Please bring your child's **labelled school supplies ([Supply list link here](#))**, **their lunch**, and a **filled and labelled water bottle** this day.

PPE/Masks:

As per the Chief Medical Officer and Minister of Education's direction, **all grade four to six students** must also come with a mask. We highly recommend sending two per day. Mask use for kindergarten to grade 3 students will continue to be optional but it is encouraged. Please practise the mask procedure described by Dr. Hinshaw in the following link.

Entrance/Exit/Cohort doors:

Your child will be entering and exiting through their cohort doors which are labelled with their grade level. This will be their cohort entrance and exit door for the year. As per the [EICS re-entry plan](#), parents will not be allowed to enter the school so please make a plan with your child where you will safely meet before and after school. For the safety of our students, please avoid the school parking lot as there are a very limited number of parking spaces. Please use the area East of the school, as a drop-off and pick up point.
