## School Funding Grant Manual:

Examples of parent engagement activities and projects that funds can be used for include:

- trainer/facilitator costs for the professional development, workshops or sessions associated with the above.

7. Examples of non-allowable expenses include:
$x$ entertainment costs, meals, snacks, other food
x no capital asset purchases
$x$ activities that have already taken place
$x$ organization memberships or conference fees $x$ fundraising events
$x$ prizes or incentives to parents and/or students
$x$ payment to school board staff including honoraria, gifts
$x$ entertainment activities such as barbeques, volunteer teas, movie nights, dances, concerts or performances, etc.
